WINE TECHNOLOGY

Type of Planting: Density 4000 plants per hectare

Type of Pruning: Guyot double strand double strand Royat

Yield per hectare (ton. / Ha): 6 ton. grape per hectare

Location of vineyards: County of Nelas, Altitude 450 m

TECHNOLOGY OENOLOGICAL

Type: Fermentation, with a temperature controlled to 25° C for 6 days.

TASTING

Good aromatic concentration, reflecting the grape variety and origin of soils, evidence shows is attractive and very fragrant, gathering notes of ripe berries, with round tannins, which give a final massive and long.

NATURAL FACTORS

Climate: Mediterranean

Soil: Granite
